LPA Membership Requirements

• New Probationary Member Dues

- \$100.00 Dues (January through end of June) and they are prorated \$50.00 (July through December)
- 1 Time initiation fee of \$100.00 (Monies will be \$200.00 or \$150.00 depending on when the proposed Member joins.)

• New Associate Member Dues

- A New Associate Member must join in affiliation of a New Junior Member
- Associate Member dues are \$50.00 (January through end of June) and they are prorated
 \$25.00 (July through December) for a Parent or Guardian.

New Junior Member Dues

- Junior Member Dues are \$50.00 (January through end of June) and they are prorated
 \$25.00 (July through December)
- o Junior members must be under the Age of 18 and join with an Associate Member
- 1 Time initiation fee of \$100.00 (Monies will be \$200.00 or \$150.00 depending on when the proposed Associate and Junior Members join (Together).

• All Member Dues must be paid by the January meeting

Proposed Members

- Must be interviewed by the Membership Committee and suggested to the membership before being voted in as members.
- Must be present at a Monthly Membership meeting to be considered and voted in by the membership.

• Members Access and Sign-in to Club and Ranges

- Access to the Ranges go from 6:00am to 12:00 midnight
- Members must sign-in at the desk in the Indoor Range or on the Sheet in the Outdoor Range Box whenever you come to the club. Guests must fill out a Waiver Card and the desk and Members must sign card as well.
- Make sure when departing the heat if used is turned down to 45°, all lights are turned off, Outdoor Target boxes and Gates Locked
- o If Bathrooms are utilized be sure to lock door when departing.

• Shooting at the Range

- Indoor Range main floor Field Points "only" and no crossbows. The Field Point diameter
 must match the shaft and be tight into the insert. Crossbows may be shot in the upstairs
 of the Indoor Range utilizing the designated targets.
- Outdoor Range Field Points only at 2 Range boxes (4x4 Block Targets) 0-100-yard distances. A Broadhead (Blob) Target and a crossbow Target and Broadhead Targets are available at the outdoor range.
- All Members are required to make one meeting per quarter
- All Members are required to attend all scheduled work parties
- <u>All Members are</u> required to make their assigned June or July Shoot. If you cannot attend it is the members responsibility to get a replacement with another member.
- All members are required to work the August Annual Bow Hunters Round Up Shoot
- <u>All members</u> are required to must contact and officer if they cannot attend a club event (Text, Phone, Email)

- All members are required to volunteer help facilitate 1 night at the NASP Kids League and Adult Winter League
- <u>LPA has affiliation</u> with the NASP, NRA, NJ Federation of Sportsman, United Bowhunters of NJ, and Central Jersey Archery
- All Members are eligible to utilize the Tech Room in the Indoor Range (Bow Presses, Arrow Cutting Saw, Arrow Fletching Jigs) but be respectful and orderly when using
- <u>All Members</u> are asked to "get involved" and volunteer to join at least one (1) club committee or you will be assigned one. Committees included are Membership, Indoor and Outdoor Range, Hunting, Kitchen, Demonstrations, House Maintenance, By Laws, Membership Promotion & Correspondence, NASP, State Federation, Traditional, Website, Women's Archers
- Any other club related topics will be discussed at the time of interview.

Members are expected to fulfill all voluntary commitments they make without a reminder from the club as well as familiarize yourself with the by-laws. All Membership requirements are subject to disciplinary action for non-compliance.
